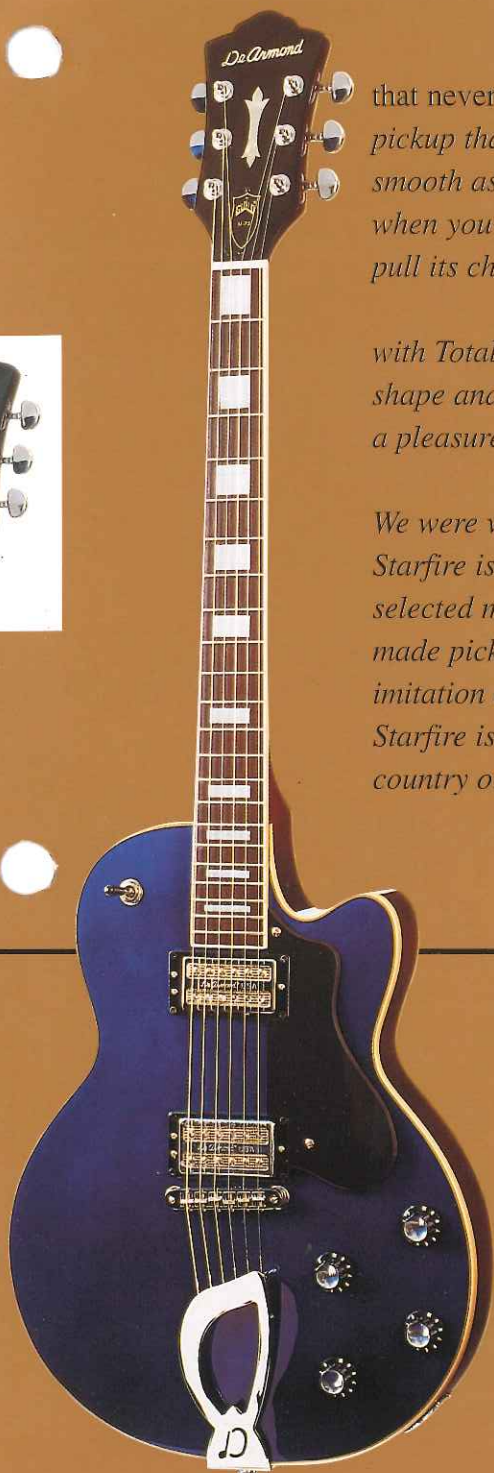

The X155 features a laminated maple body and a bound maple neck with a rosewood fretboard decorated with pearlloid block inlays. All the style points are there from the art deco pickguard to the Guild style tailpiece.

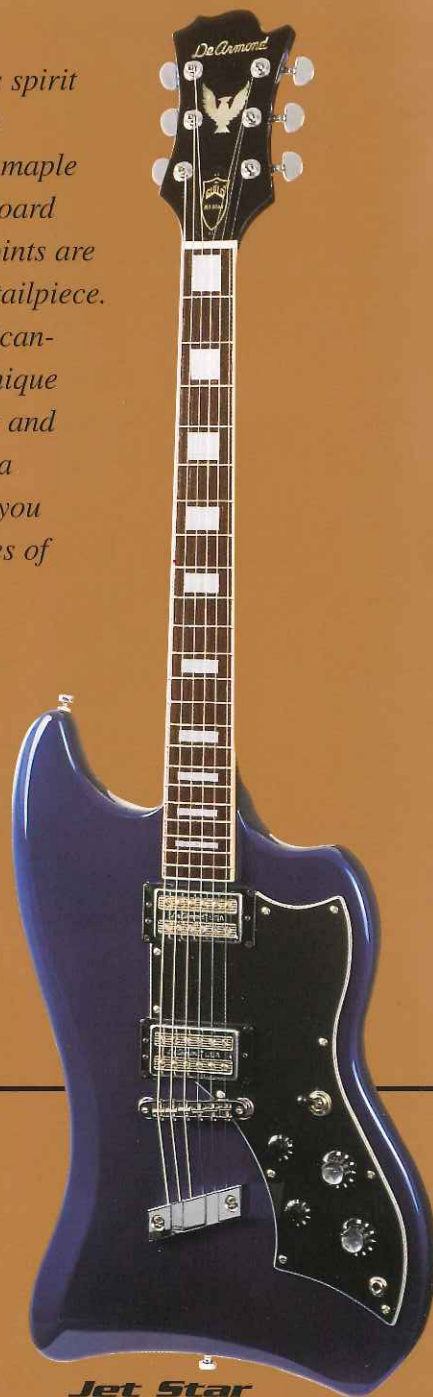

2K Single Coil

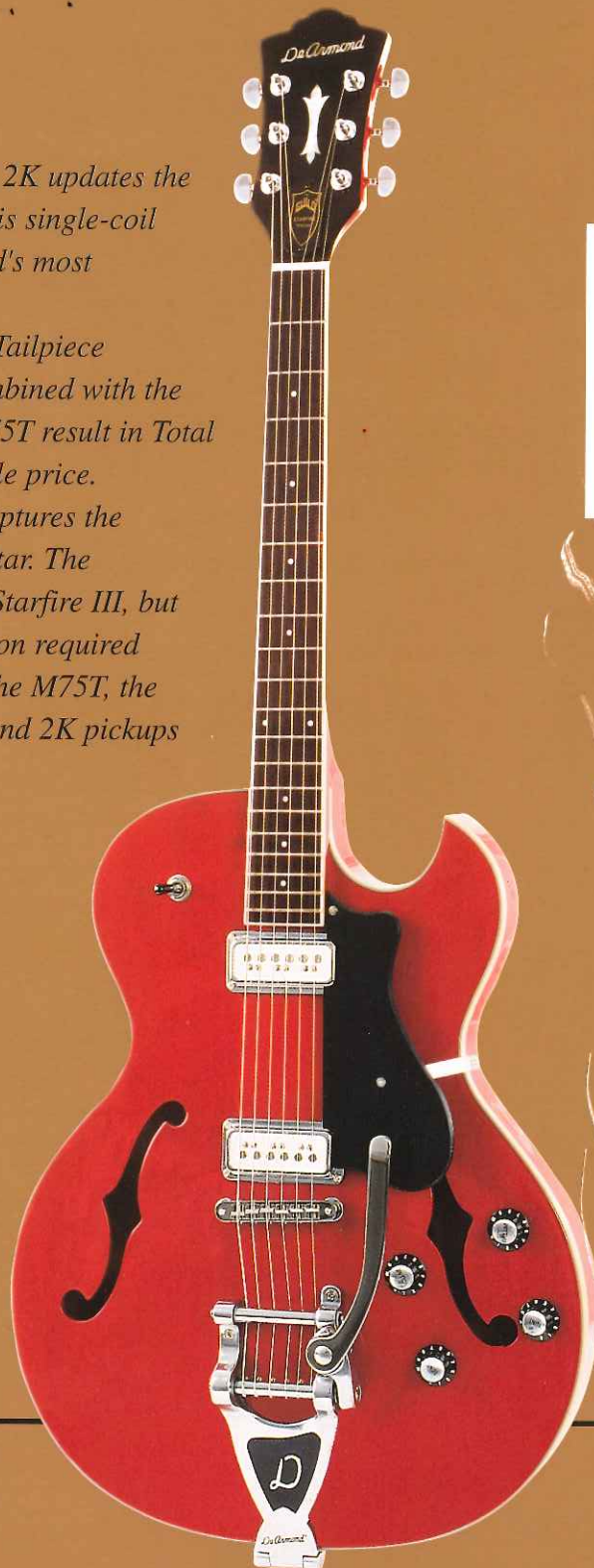
The DeArmond Model 2K updates the original DeArmond Model 2000. This single-coil pickup is found on some of the world's most collectable guitars.

The DeArmond Vibro-Tailpiece and American-made 2K pickups combined with the vintage Guild body design of the M75T result in Total Sonic Response at a totally affordable price.

The Starfire Special captures the sound of the sixties like no other guitar. The body looks just like Guild's classic Starfire III, but has the solid center-block construction required for high volume performance. Like the M75T, the Starfire Special has a set of DeArmond 2K pickups and Vibro-Tailpiece.

The DeArmond Starfire bass features two American-made Gold Tone humbuckers. With a smooth well balanced response that remains clear even in the low registers, this sweet sounding instrument has the same classic look as the Starfire guitar.

The Jet Star Bass is powered by two American-made DeArmond Turbo Jet single coil bass pickups and sports the same in-your-face look as the Jet Star guitar. The short scale, 30-3/4" neck, is easy on your hands and the two pickups each have an independent volume control with a mastertone control.

M55

This straight ahead, single pickup guitar kicks out the jams with a rocking humbucker that delivers. The comfortable bolt-on neck has dot inlays on a rosewood fretboard. Functional hardware adds to the simple grace of the M55. The M55 also features an adjustable bridge and Gold-style tailpiece.

Available in Black, Trans Red and Desert Sand finishes.



M65

The M65 is special indeed. This bolt-neck, single-cutaway, double-pickup guitar has a sleek contoured body that fits all comers. It has a master volume and master tone control and a conveniently placed three way pickup selector. Chrome tuners, an adjustable bridge and tailpiece complete the M65.

M65C

The M65C carved-top says rock and roll all the way. The top of the DeArmond bolt-neck series, the M65C has all the appointments and features you want in a great guitar. Block inlays, chrome hardware, chrome covered humbucking pickups... Separate volume and tone controls produce the look you want and the sound you need.

It features two humbucking pickups, master volume and tone controls and a 3-way pickup selector. If you want to set yourself apart from the crowd the Jetstar Special is the place to start. Available in Black and Trans Red finishes.



Jet Star Special Bass

Like it's matching guitar the Jetstar Special Bass exudes individual style. The split-coil pickup sounds fat and punchy and the shape says "I go my own way". The 34" scale, fast action neck feels great in your hands. Available in Black and Trans Red.
